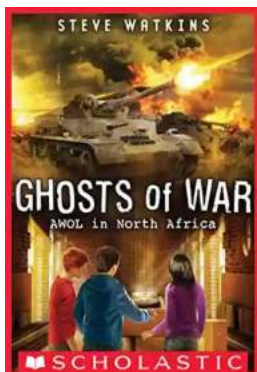


AWOL in North Africa: Ghosts of War
