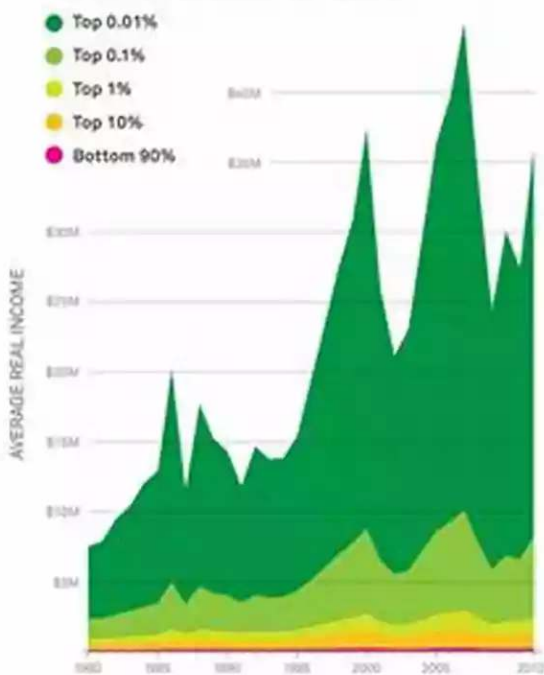

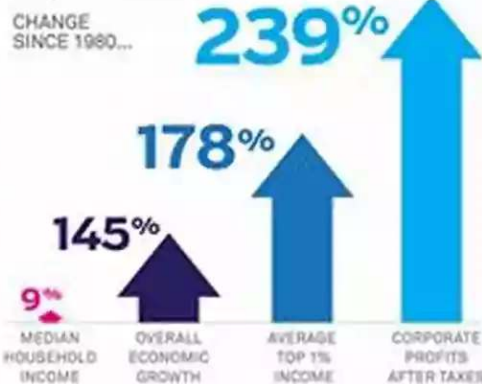
THE RICH AND THE MEGARICH

If the median household had enjoyed the same income growth as the 1 percent since 1980, it would now make more than \$140,000.

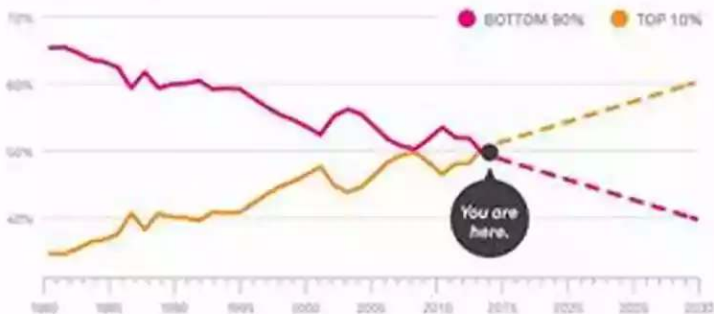

SHARE OF TOTAL INCOME

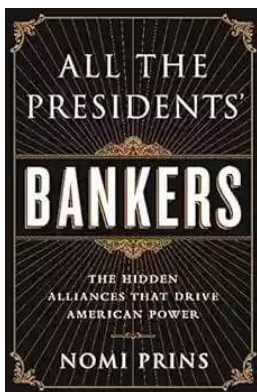

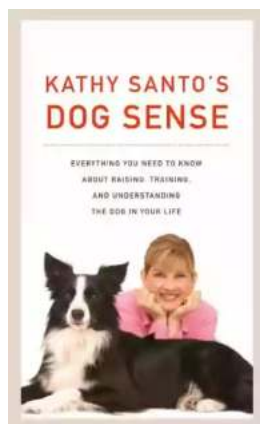
