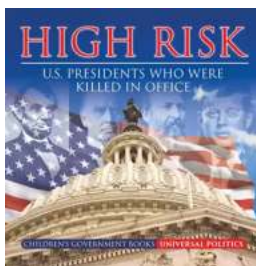
We are not uncritical in our enthusiasm for County Cricket, but, as we spelt out in our first edition, we want to see the championship promoted, celebrated, and

played throughout the year, and we want consideration given to ways of growing the game which do not destroy what we already have. Most of all, we want recognition that County Cricket matters.



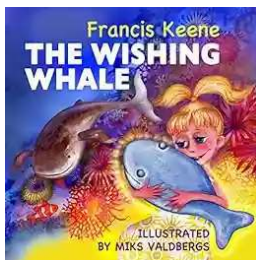

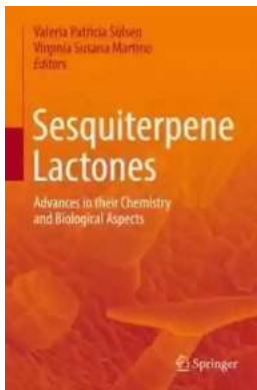

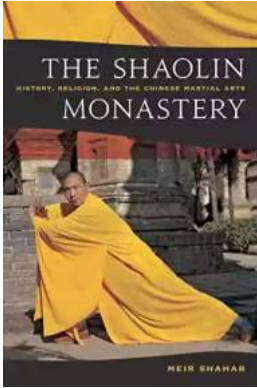
