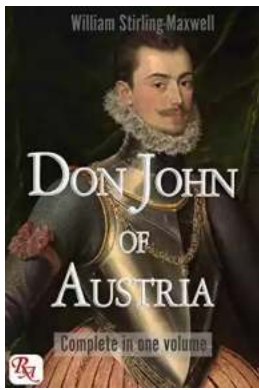

Like a fairytale prince a child called Jerome was brought up in obscurity, ignorant of his parentage. But this prince had no crown waiting for him. He was illegitimate, and his father was the emperor Charles V.

Philip II, the legitimate heir, obeyed his father's dying wishes and acknowledged Jerome, now known as Don John. Philip gave him a status and privilege only a

little below that of his own son, Don Carlos. The two princes, close in age, became firm friends.

The whole is rounded off with numerous illustrations, mostly contemporary.
