Although simple, this approach is also powerful. All of the polar/ionic reactions in undergraduate organic can be studied using this method.



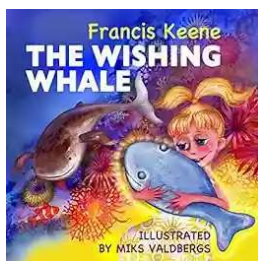
