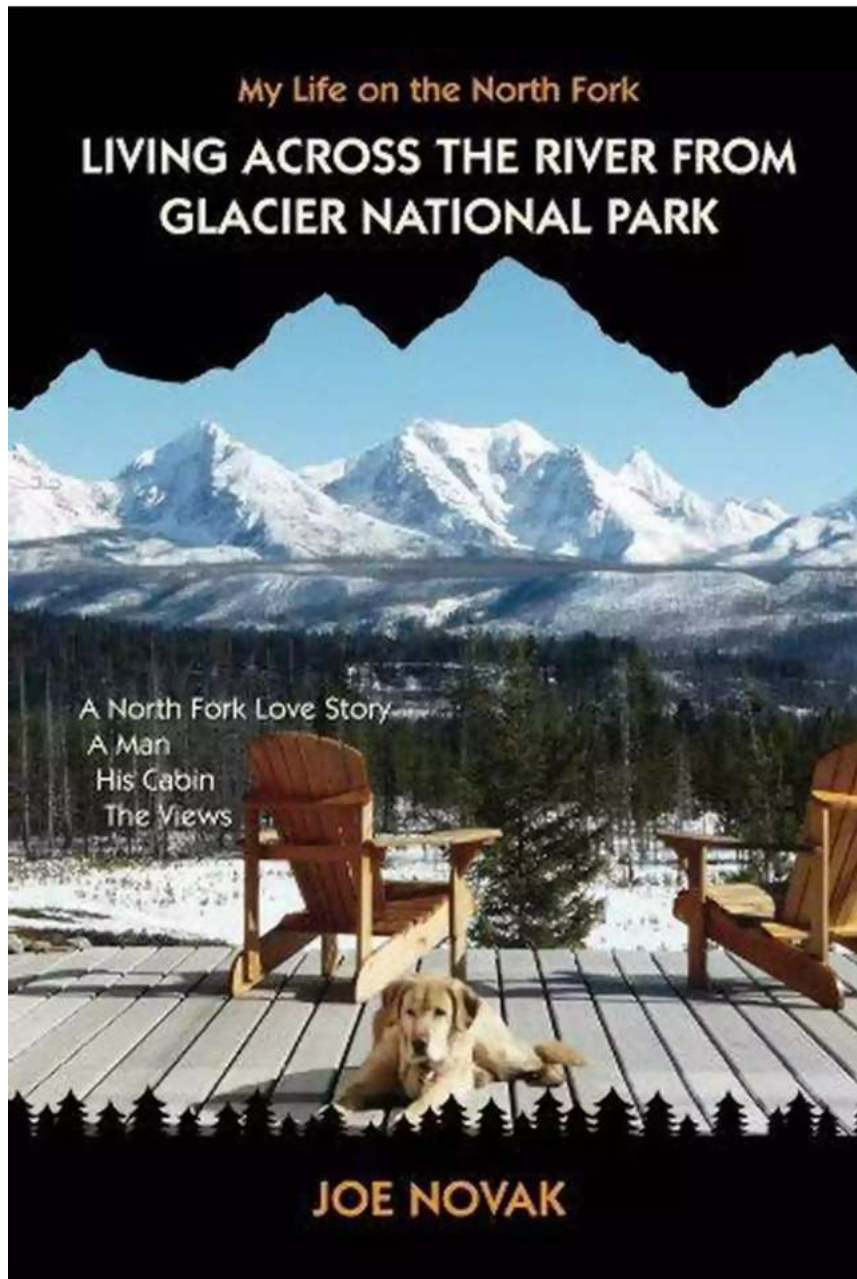

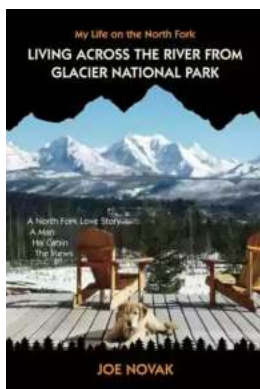

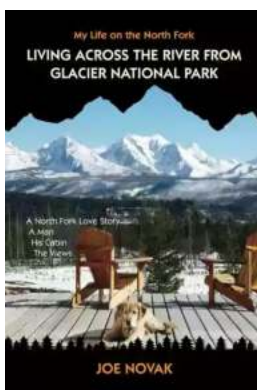

This is his story of deciding to buy upon first sight a piece of property far removed from the comforts of civilization.

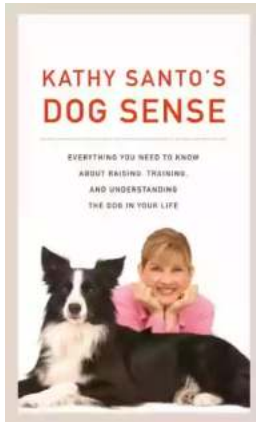
He immediately fell in love when visiting ten acres that were for sale in 1995. It wasn't the ten acres that left him speechless, but the surrounding area.

This is the story of his journey, and the experiences, challenges, and difficulties of living on that land, eventually year-round.

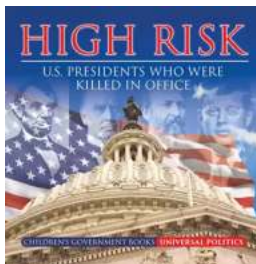
He has survived a forest fire and a near drowning to chronicle the people he has come to know, the seasons, the views, and the wildlife.

It is ultimately a love story-his love of what is commonly known as the North Fork.



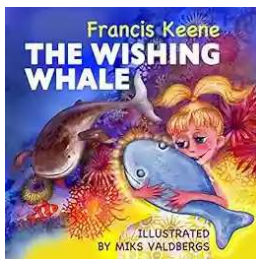
