

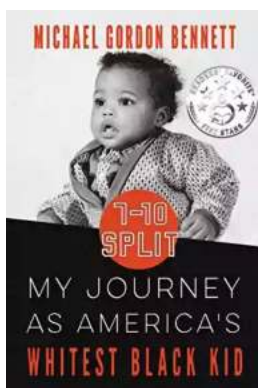
My Journey As America's Whitest Black Kid

Embracing the "Whitest Black Kid" Label

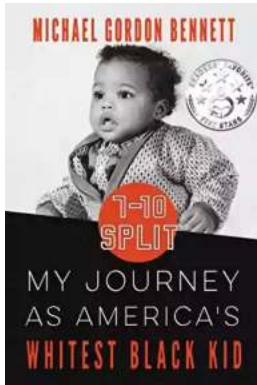

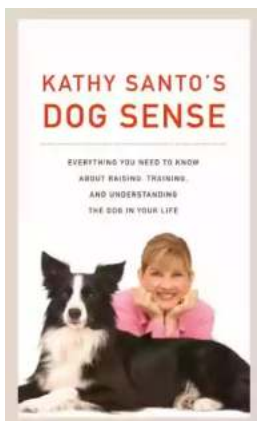
