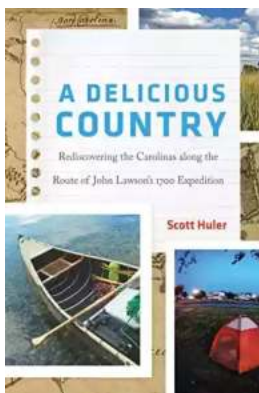

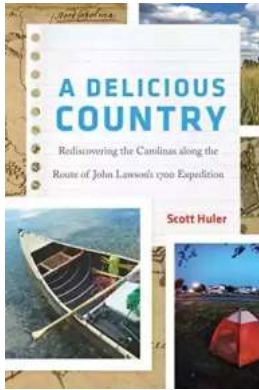

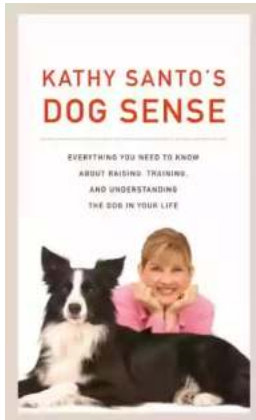

In 1700, a young man named John Lawson left London and landed in Charleston, South Carolina, hoping to make a name for himself. 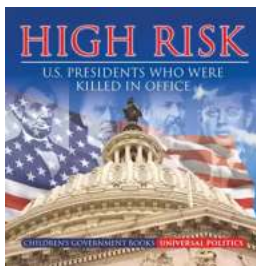
