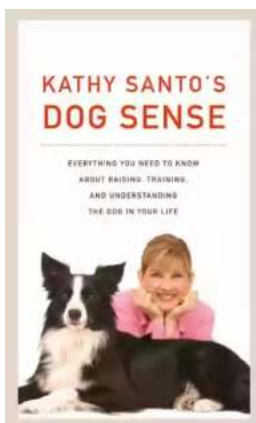
Thomas L Knowlton: Colonel, Patriot, Spymaster, and Soldier of the American Revolution.
