Literature in 1902. This edition was created so that readers can have all of Mommsen's works as a set, in one place on their Kindle devices.

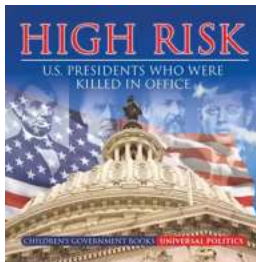
