"After breaking up with my ex whom I called " the manipulator" I was 25. I did not want to start a relationship, but just wanted to take a break from it all."

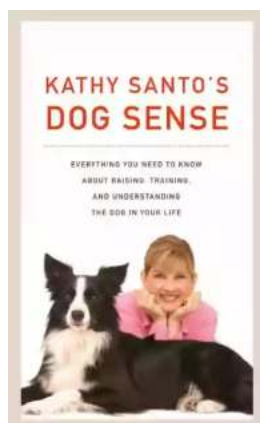
"However, 2 years later, when I was 27,..."

"I gave her a souvenir - a piece of iron wire that I found on the road."

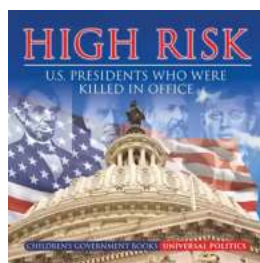
"Then SHE took my hand and said "Let's go to s..."
