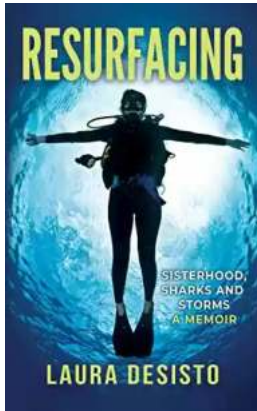

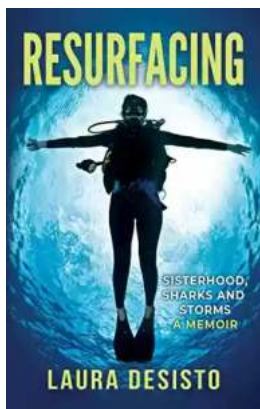

“I see D37!” says Buffy. “We’re almost there.”

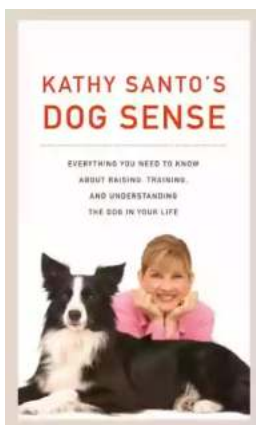
